All keys and any opening devices to premises also must be returned to the landlord. Your security deposit of \$ will be returned in full, partially, or not at all depending on the condition of the premises.
If you fail to quit and deliver possession, legal action will be instituted against you to obtain possession and such proceedings could result in a judgment against you, which may include attorney's fees and court costs as allowed by law. This legal action will also result in forfeiture of the rental agreement. This Notice to Vacate does not relieve you of responsibility for payment of any financial obligations under the lease until the actual date of termination of tenancy. Your security deposit may not be used to pay for your last month's rent.
